REQUIREMENTS & FEES

1. Bring one grocery bag (per hour visit) full of vegetables and fruits for the twelve bunny pets—e.g. broccoli, celery, cilantro, kale, spinach, parsley, apples, bananas, cherries, peaches, pears. 4 hours = 4 bags of veges
2. Provide two copies (print/video/DVD) of published article or story segment.
3. Inform museum of the date of published article or aired story segment.
4. The fee is \$500.00 to use footage from Candace & Steve’s 1994 Wedding Video.
5. Bring extra lighting as museum is dark in areas.
